

# Translating the Aged Care Quality Standards

## Online Evergreen Course

### Who is this course for?

Dietitians with limited knowledge or experience with the new Quality Standards.

### What are the learning objectives of this course?

- To identify and promote the role that dietitians have in supporting organisations to meet the new Aged Care Quality Standards relating to food and nutrition.
- To advocate for better quality food and nutrition processes in aged care through understanding how the Standards relate to dietetic practice.
- To interpret the Quality Standards to promote higher quality food and mealtime services, by supporting organisations to facilitate change through all aspects of meal planning, meal-time services and meeting nutrition requirements for consumers.

### How long will I have access to the course?
